

Fairhaven Substance Use Policy

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This has been and will continue to be our policy on certain drugs and medications:

Although not a comprehensive list, and there very well will be more to consider, but the following drugs are not allowed as medications and/or are considered banned/“illegal substances” within our homes:

- Naloxone, Pentazocine, Suboxone (buprenorphine and naloxone combo)
- Barbiturates: Phenobarbital, Seconal, Tuinal, Secobarbital, Pentobarbital
- Narcotics (opiates): Methadone, Vicodin, OxyContin, Percocet, Percodan, codeine, hydrocodone, oxycodone, Demerol, meperidine, Fentanyl, Morphine, etc.
- THC (legal or not)
- Benzodiazepines: Valium, Clonazepam, Lorazepam, Klonopin, Ativan, Librium, Xanax, Restoril, Celexa, Diazepam.
- Stimulants; Adderall, Ritalin, Concerta, Amphetamine, Methamphetamine, Dexedrine, Methylphenidate, dextroamphetamine, Ritalin
- “Spice”, “Bath Salts”, Kratom, Ecstasy (MDMA)
- Alcohol, or anything with alcohol in it...

Be aware of the generic vs brand names vs type of drugs. Valium is a “brand”, generic name is diazepam, but it’s still a benzodiazepine.
